Competition Statistics and Analysis Report

Executive Summary

The OAC Open 2025 recorded a total of **340 registrations** from **44 countries**. Of these, **156 participants** took part in the open round, and **34 qualified** for the next stage based on performance and submission criteria. The mean score was **77.2**, the median **65**, and the highest score **175**.

1 Registration Statistics

A total of 340 individuals registered for the competition, spanning 44 countries. Participants from India, the United States, and Indonesia comprised approximately 63.5% of all registrants. Most contestants were in grades 11 and 12, aged 16 or 17.




Figure 1: Distribution of participants by country.




Figure 2: Age distribution of registered participants.




Figure 3: Grade distribution of registered participants.

2 Participation Details

Out of all registrants, 156 individuals participated in the open round, representing 31 countries. Each received a Certificate of Participation. A total of 34 contestants qualified for the next round, as indicated in the official results sheet.

Qualification Criteria

Participants qualified if they:

- Scored 77 or higher
- Submitted valid scrapwork

Any suspected cases of academic dishonesty resulted in disqualification.

- Question 29 had the highest correct response rate.




Figure 4: Distribution of participant scores.




Figure 5: Mean score contribution by question.




Figure 6: Mean score of participants by country.
